BY THE COMMISSION: On April 26, 2023, the Commission issued an Order Approving Partial Settlement Agreement and Stipulation, Deciding Contested Issues, Granting Partial Rate Increase, Approving Water and Sewer Investment Plan, and Requiring Customer Notice (Rate Order) in the above-referenced proceeding. Among other things, the Rate Order required that the Public Staff and Carolina Water Service Inc. of North Carolina (CWSNC) jointly file, within five business days of the date of the order, Schedules of Rates, applicable Notices to Customers, and Schedules of Connection fees for CWSNC's Base Case, and Schedules of Rates and applicable Customer Notices for WSIP Rate Year 1, WSIP Rate Year 2, and WSIP Rate Year 3.

On May 3, 2023, CWSNC and the Public Staff jointly filed with the Commission, as appendices to its filing, the applicable Schedules of Rates and Connection Fees and Notices to Customers.

Based upon the foregoing and the entire record, the Commission concludes that good cause exists to approve the Schedules of Rates and Connection Fees and Notices to Customers attached to this Order.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That the Base Case Schedules of Rates, attached hereto as Appendices A-1 and A-2, and the Schedules of Connection Fees for Uniform Water and Uniform Sewer, attached hereto as Appendices B-1 and B-2, are hereby approved and deemed to be filed with the Commission pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-138, and are hereby authorized to become effective for service rendered on and after January 31, 2023, through March 31, 2023, solely for purposes of comparing rates collected by CWSNC under partial, temporary rates to the rates ultimately approved by the Commission for determination of whether refunds are due to customers;

- 2. That the Schedules of Connection Fees for Uniform Water and Uniform Sewer, attached hereto as Appendices B-1 and B-2, are hereby approved and deemed to be filed with the Commission pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-138, and are hereby authorized to become effective for service rendered on and after the issuance date of the Rate Order and shall remain in effect until further order of the Commission;
- 3. That the WSIP Rate Year 1 Schedules of Rates, attached hereto as Appendices C-1 and C-2, are hereby approved and deemed to be filed with the Commission pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-138, and are hereby authorized to become effective for service rendered on and after April 1, 2023, through March 31, 2024;
- 4. That the WSIP Rate Year 2 Schedules of Rates, attached hereto as Appendices D-1 and D-2, are hereby approved and deemed to be filed with the Commission pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-138, and are hereby authorized to become effective for service rendered on and after April 1, 2024, through March 31, 2025;
- 5. That the WSIP Rate Year 3 Schedules of Rates, attached hereto as Appendices E-1 and E-2, are hereby approved and deemed to be filed with the Commission pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-138, and are hereby authorized to become effective for service rendered on and after April 1, 2025, and shall remain in effect until new rates are authorized by further order of the Commission;
- 6. That the Notices to Customers, attached hereto as Appendix F-1 (RY1) and Appendix F-2 (RY1) shall be mailed with sufficient postage or hand delivered to all affected customers in each relevant service area, respectively, in conjunction with the next regularly scheduled billing process;
- 7. That at least 30 days prior to implementation of rates effective for Rate Years 2 and 3, CWSNC shall provide notice to customers of the rates to be implemented as of those respective effective dates. The Notices to Customers for Rate Years 2 and 3 are attached hereto as Appendix F-1 (RY2), Appendix F-2 (RY2), Appendix F-1 (RY3), and Appendix F-2 (RY3); and

8. That CWSNC shall file the attached Certificate of Service, properly signed and notarized, not later than ten days after the Notices to Customers are mailed or hand delivered to customers.

WATER AND SEWER INVESTMENT PLAN:

The Commission has authorized the water and sewer investment plan (WSIP) rate-making mechanism pursuant to G.S. 62-133.1B and Commission Rule R1-17A. The WSIP allows CWSNC to recover the reasonably known and measurable capital investments and anticipated reasonable and prudent expenses approved under the WSIP. The Commission has approved a three-year plan which includes proposed water and sewer capital investment projects, anticipated water and sewer expenses, and the proposed rates to be effective in each year of the WSIP. By law, any rate adjustment allowed under an approved WSIP shall not, on an annual basis for years two and three of the WSIP, exceed five percent of the utility's North Carolina retail jurisdictional gross revenues for the preceding plan year. The Commission may, however, consider the addition of certain unplanned emergency capital investments even if such expenditures would cause the cap to be exceeded. Additional information regarding the WSIP is contained in the Commission's Order and can be accessed from the Commission's website at www.ncuc.net, under Docket Information, using the Docket Search feature fordocket number "W-354 Sub 400".

RATE ADJUSTMENT MECHANISM:

The Commission-authorized water and sewer system improvement charge (WSIC/SSIC) rate adjustment mechanism will not be in effect during CWSNC's WSIP. Immediately upon termination of the WSIP, CWSNC is authorized to reinitiate implementation of the WSIC/SSIC rate adjustment mechanism and may file a request with the Commission for authority to impose such surcharges.
